

AIR CONDITIONING

— *SUMMER PREP* —

CHECKLIST

BEFORE THE FIRST START UP

- Check outdoor unit. Remove any leaves or other debris from around unit.
- Cut back any vegetation to give outdoor unit room to breathe.
- Make sure the circuit breaker is in the ON position.
- Check the air filter and replace if dirty.
- If you have a humidifier, make sure it is off. Make sure dampers are set to summer position.
- All registers should be opened and unobstructed.
- Double check thermostat to make sure it's in the cooling mode and the program is correct, replace batteries in thermostat yearly if applicable.
- Schedule a tune-up to make sure unit is not only operating correctly but also to make sure it's running efficiently.

SIGNS YOUR AC NEEDS TO BE SERVICED OR REPLACED

- The unit seems to be running longer than usual.
- The system seems to be noisy when it runs.
- The system is struggling to reach the desired temperature.
- Your electric bill is higher than normal.
- If someone has added refrigerant in the past, it's wise to find the leak or have the unit replaced.
- The airflow coming out of vents seems low.
- You see ice on the lines between the outdoor unit and the indoor coil.
- Sometimes, it's wise to replace a unit because of age. Newer units are much more efficient and you shouldn't be losing sleep wondering if the current system is going to last one more week.
